## **QUALITY OF EDUCATION**

- Focus on evidence-based practices & educational **research** to inform instruction
- Reading/math screening data analyzed each term & applied to classroom instruction
- K-3 reading/math small group intervention
- **Gr. 5 flooding intervention** (students grouped across classes for targeted reading instruction for 40 lessons)
- Individual Program Plans (IPPs) & Behaviour Support **Plans** for students with identified needs
- Formalized testing for 13 students to identify learning needs & refer to system supports
- Collaborative Response Model: regular teacher meetings to analyze data, share best practices, & develop high quality universal instruction for all students

### PARENT INVOLVEMENT

- Monthly **school council** meeting to give advice to administration
- **Fundraising** through DCFS parent group sponsors lunch clubs, classroom funds & prizes for Family Math Night
- Hot lunch parent volunteers provide fun lunches and snacks once/twice a month
- Parents **volunteer** for field trips & as class helpers
- Attend **student-led assemblies** once a month
- **Christmas Concert & Remembrance Day Ceremony**
- DCFS sponsored Family Wellness Night, with a FitSet Ninja obstacle course and a parent session presented by Family Community Services!
- High levels of parent attendance at events regularly see over a 100 families at school events! Go, Mustangs!

### STUDENT LEARNING & ENGAGEMENT

- **Lunch clubs** connect to **future career paths** including sports, games, hobbies, horticulture, leadership & more!
- **Field trips** to extend learning in all grades
- **Special projects** presented to school and parent community
- Student art displayed at library and EIPS central office
- K-3 Swimming lessons provide a life saving skill!
- **DCE Volleyball tournament** to develop leadership
- January Dance Party organized by student leadership club for entire school
- Hands on science lessons dropping eggs from the 2nd floor & launching paper air planes in the halls!
- **Brain breaks** calm hyper brains/energize sleepy brains!
- Student absenteeism is below the division average!

# FIRST NATIONS, MÉTIS & INUIT

- Lead teachers (Mrs. Kellough & Ms. Falcon) modeling lessons, sharing resources and leading professional learning in staff meetings
- First Nations, Metis and Inuit students: access monthly smudging, & teachings such as land literacy, beading, and Cree language
- First Nations, Metis & Inuit parent volunteers assist with teachings
- **Edukits** used in class to support foundational knowledge
- Education for Reconciliation: Orange Shirt Day, Project of Heart,
- Staff book study: Speaking Our Truth by Monique Gray Smith
- Teaching Tuesdays: video segments in video announcements with teachings from various Indigenous communities

### CITIZENSHIP

- **Buddy classes:** older student mentorship
- 12 Days of Christmas: collected 2267 lbs of food for Strathcona County Food Bank
- Terry Fox Run \$2181.50 donation
- Student leadership club: plan & run spirit events such as contests and dances
- **Safety Patrollers**: keep people safe when crossing the street
- **Lunch helpers:** Gr. 6 students help K-1 students at lunch
- Mustang Mentions: celebrating good choices with 678 positive referrals so far!
- **Restorative Practices:** sharing circles build empathy, respect & connection



- Mental Health Capacity Project: lessons with Miss Julia on the brain, stress, anxiety & how to help (students AND parent council meetings)
- **Counsellors** run small groups, support for social skills, & coach staff
- Staff book study: Connections Over Compliance by Dr. Lori Desautels
- Mindfulness Kits: each class equipped with tools such as noise cancelling headphones, timers, Hoberman spheres, singing bowls, fidgets
